

## RELATIONAL VAMPIRES—3 NEEDY PEOPLE

### HOW DO WE HELP WITHOUT HURTING?

#### 1) WE GIVE STRATEGICALLY.

*When he saw Peter and John about to enter, he asked them for money. <sup>4</sup> Peter looked straight at him, as did John. Then Peter said, “Look at us!” <sup>5</sup> So the man gave them his attention, expecting to get something from them. Acts 3:3-5*

*Then Peter said, “Silver or gold I do not have, but what I do have I give you. In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, walk.” <sup>7</sup> Taking him by the right hand, he helped him up, and instantly the man’s feet and ankles became strong. Acts 3:6-7*

#### 2) WE SERVE WISELY.

*Very early in the morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house and went off to a solitary place, where he prayed. <sup>36</sup> Simon and his companions went to look for him,<sup>37</sup> and when they found him, they exclaimed: “Everyone is looking for you!” Mark 1:35-37*

- You can’t say “yes” often if you don’t say “no” occasionally.

#### 3) WE TRUST COMPLETELY.

*Do not be deceived: God cannot be mocked. A man reaps what he sows. <sup>8</sup> Whoever sows to please their flesh, from the flesh will reap destruction; whoever sows to please the Spirit, from the Spirit will reap eternal life. Galatians 6:7-8*

*But as for me, I am poor and needy; come quickly to me, O God. You are my help and my deliverer; Lord, do not delay. Psalm 70:5*
