



Statement Regarding Coronavirus

Updated November 2, 2020

Hello New Life Church!

Our region, along with the rest of New York, is currently in phase 4 of reopening. Here are some things to keep in mind because Coronavirus is still active and we have to be smart:

- If you don't feel comfortable attending in-person, have symptoms of COVID-19, have tested positive for COVID-19, have been in close contact (defined as within 6 feet of an infected person for more than 15 total minutes) with a person who tested positive, were told to quarantine from home by the school/county, or have traveled to those places on the department of health's travel advisory, please join us from home via live stream. - We will strictly observe the capacity limits set by the state, which in phase 4 is 33% of the maximum occupancy, and while we don't anticipate that this will happen, we do apologize in advance if we have to stop admittance due to reaching capacity. We encourage you to [pre-register](#) for services to help us manage our capacity and cooperate with contact tracing efforts.
- Service will begin at 10 AM, and doors will be opened for admittance at 9:45 AM. For the safety of our staff & volunteers, we kindly ask that you do not enter the building before 9:45, but we do encourage you to arrive 5 to 15 minutes before the service begins to avoid congestion and close contact at the front doors.
- We must maintain social distance, wear our face coverings, and practice hand hygiene! We will have face coverings if you need one, plenty of hand sanitizer, and we've removed a lot of chairs and spaced the rows and isles to ensure social distance.
 - Please wear your masks and sanitize your hands upon entry.
 - Face coverings are required at all times except while seated, provided all individuals are 6 ft. apart except for immediate household members. Be prepared to don a face covering if another person unexpectedly comes within 6 ft. (e.g. when walking to seats). Any time employees, volunteers, and/or attendees must come within 6 ft. of one another (or 12 ft., if singing), they must wear acceptable face coverings, unless they are members of the same household. Our on-stage singers and speakers will not wear face coverings but will maintain appropriate social distance.
 - A distance of at least 6 ft. must be maintained amongst all individuals at all times, unless the individuals are members of the same household. Please sit in a row with the members of your household. If members of different households sit in the same row, please leave 3 empty chairs between the parties.
 - Please refrain from holding hands, shaking hands, hugging, etc. except for immediate household members.
- Services will be shorter than normal - less than one hour.
- The multi-stall restrooms in the fellowship hall will be closed. The single-stall restrooms in the hallway will be available for emergency use.
- We will utilize offering drop boxes and prepackaged communion elements to avoid passing plates.
- There will be no Nursery, however, ***KidZone has resumed. Please refer to the Coronavirus Guidelines for KidZone for more information.*** Your children are welcome to join us in "big church," however If you believe your children will be unable to sit with you through the service, or you are not yet comfortable allowing them to go to KidZone, please consider joining us from home and watching the live stream.
- There will be no paper bulletins, but our sermon notes and announcements will be available on the [Bible App](#) under "Events" and as a PDF on our [website](#).
- There will be no coffee & bagels. After the service, we will be dismissed in an orderly fashion and exit immediately to the parking lot to avoid close contact.

- Most mid-week services remain cancelled at this time, however, ***Finish Line Youth Group has resumed.***
Please refer to the Coronavirus Guidelines for Youth Group for more information.

Please know that the church board is doing everything we can to make our facilities safe and honor our governing authorities and that we are very excited to gather with you for worship!

Obviously, this is a very fluid and dynamic situation, and these plans are subject to change.
